SUMMER CAMP PROGRAMME

Students Summer Camp in China is an annual event that gives the selected group an opportunity to travel and stay in China for a period of two weeks. During this time they study Chinese language and are exposed to aspects of Chinese culture.

Students are selected on the basis of their performance before an interview panel as well as their interest and participation in various activities of the Confucius Institute. Only a maximum number of 20 are selected each year hence the programme is very competitive.



SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Confucius Institute headquarters, Hanban awards CI students Chinese scholarships to enhance their chinese language acqisiton and career development. The scholarships are normally six months, one year and four year degree programme. They are offered to those who have passed HSK examination and have qualified based on the current selection criteria.

The Confucius Institute Scholarships provide full coverage of tuition fee, accommodation fee, living allowance (four-week study students are excluded) and comprehensive medical insurance expenses.
